## **Code of Conduct for Parents / Carers**

Encourage your child to attend club coaching sessions and to learn new skills.

Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results.

Never force your child to take part in orienteering or to run a course for which they are not ready

Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes.

Support your child's involvement and help them enjoy their orienteering.

Use correct and proper language at all times.

'Fair Play' in orienteering should be encouraged, for example - not complaining about the map, course planning and control placement. Having respect for the countryside; not tampering with controls and not entering out of bounds areas.
